

## 2022 Big Bend Filipino-American Association (BBFAA) Student Service Award Purpose of the BBFAA Student Service Award:

This BBFAA Scholarship award will be provided to the high school senior or college student, who has dedicated and worked the most BBFAA volunteer hours. All volunteer hours must be worked at the FSU concession stands or BBFAA events, such as Pista sa Nayon Filipino Festival, BBFAA Adopt-a-Street, or Filipino Mass for the year 2022.

The volunteer hours will be recorded and submitted by the high school senior, or college student, and signatures must be obtained to verify that they had worked the number of service hours recorded on their application. All volunteer hours must have been completed during the year 2022. In addition, the high school senior or college student applicant must write a 150-to-200-word essay about the importance of BBFAA to them and the community.

Points will weigh heavily on the number of volunteer hours the student has completed. Although student applicants (and their families) are not required to be a BBFAA member, additional points will be awarded if the student's family are members of the BBFAA. Membership dues for family membership is \$25.00, which can be paid online at BBFAA.org. Additional points will be awarded based on the essay submitted.

Only one \$500 scholarship award will be provided to the top BBFAA Student Service Scholarship Award winner with the most points. The \$500 award will be submitted to the student through the university or college that the student will be attending. For high school seniors, their \$500 awards will be received during the semester when they start attending college or university.

Deadline to submit: December 1, 2022

## How to Apply:

- 1. Complete and submit the BBFAA Student Service Award Application.
- 2. Submit a 150-to-200-word essay on the importance of BBFAA to you and the community.
- Complete and submit the Student Volunteer Hours Sheet and have it signed by a BBFAA Officer. All service hours must have been completed during the year 2022.
